THE AWARD

The Patricia A. Gee Memorial Scholarship is a \$1000 award given annually to a high school senior planning to enroll as a full-time freshman at an accredited college or university. Applicants must demonstrate above average academic achievement on their high school transcript and demonstrate strong leadership abilities.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be a member in good standing or a family member of a School Systems FCU member in good standing who meets all of the following criteria:

- college-bound high school senior at the time of application
- attending college for the first time in the fall of 2019
- has a high school average of 88 or above
- has strong leadership abilities through involvement in non-classroom high school organizations, the local community, service groups or other similar activities
